Dear Senator Enzi:

As organizations that care about the quality of emergency medical care provided to children across our nation, we respectfully request that you support the placement of S. 60, the Wakefield Act, a bill to reauthorize the Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC) program, on the committee's markup calendar.

Since its establishment over 20 years ago, the EMSC program has driven major improvements in emergency care for children. Injury-related deaths among children have dropped by 40 percent over that period of time. Enormous strides have been made in areas such as ensuring that all ambulances carry appropriate pediatric equipment and supplies, establishing transfer protocols to assure that severely injured children are sent to the facilities best able to care for them, and collecting and analyzing data on pediatric emergency care to inform future efforts toward improvement.

Although much progress has been made, more remains to be done. The EMSC program's authorization expired in September 2005. S. 60 has bipartisan, bicameral support as well as the endorsement of over 50 organizations. We urge you to support markup of this legislation as soon as possible to ensure that this program may continue its vital work on behalf of our nation's children.
