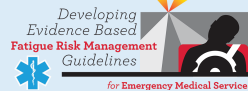
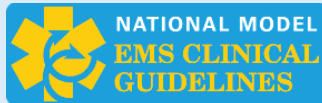

NASEMSO Councils

Data Managers: formulates recommendations on policies and positions specific to EMS data systems. The Council serves as a national leader in developing and maintaining a fully-integrated and functioning National EMS Information System (NEMSIS) in all states and territories.

Breakout Session or Webinar 50 Credits. *Your topic, your speaker. Limited availability.* Review science, technology, industry trends, or best practices with event attendees via breakout session at our Annual Meeting or as an offeror of a webinar to NASEMSO members.

Sole Sponsor of President's Hospitality Suite 40 Credits. Host a gathering of meeting attendees in the President's Suite for networking purposes. Always a favorite member activity!

Featured Product or Service Listing in Washington Update 25 Credits *per issue. Limit one sponsor per issue.* Each month, NASEMSO distributes an e-newsletter to NASEMSO members, partners, and EMS supporters (direct subscribers of 1500, forwarded to hundreds more EMS practitioners by our members.) Your product or service banner or corporate logo can be featured with a link to your web site.
