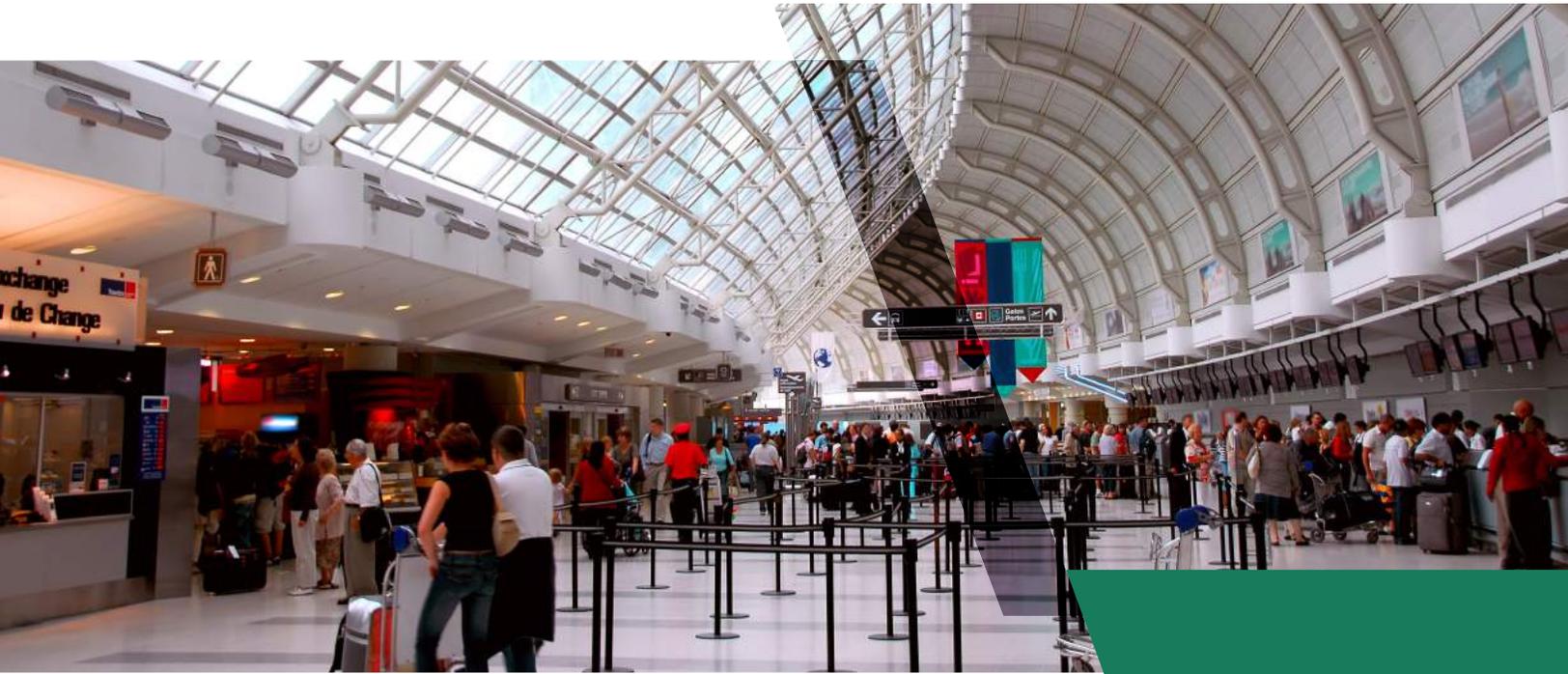

What is the Airport Cooperative Research Program?

The Airport Cooperative Research Program (ACRP) is an industry-driven, applied research program that develops near-term, practical solutions to problems faced by airport operators. ACRP is managed by the Transportation Research Board (TRB) of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine and is sponsored by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The research is conducted by contractors who are selected on the basis of competitive proposals.

What is an ACRP Insight Event?

An ACRP Insight Event will bring together airport industry leaders, subject matter experts, and researchers from appropriate fields to facilitate discussion with the goal of promoting broader and deeper insight on topics of significance to airport operators. These in-depth discussions are intended to facilitate communication and incubate collaboration with the industry and help identify areas of future research needs. In addition, the events are expected to promote efficiency and synergistic efforts within the airport industry, while accelerating the identification of innovation in this transportation sector.

Established in 2015, ACRP Insight Events bring airport industry leaders and subject matter experts from various fields together to discuss and explore topics of significance to airport operations.
